Due to the small number of cast members, all cast members will be called for all rehearsals.

**THERE WILL BE REHEARSALS OVER SPRING BREAK. Auditioners who will be out of town during Spring Break (March 13-17) will not be eligible for casting.**

### About the Tour

The Open Theatre project annually produces a production which tours to local and area schools.

The cast members will need to miss all or a portion of 5-6 days of school in order to travel to neighboring counties for performances. These will be excused absences.

### About the Show

The show, which is geared toward elementary aged children tells the story of a "brave" spider's desire to bring stories into the world and the difficult challenges he faces achieving his goal. Throughout it all Anansi thinks himself clever, but in reality, it is only with the help of his wife Osa, who is really the clever one in the family, that Anansi is able to achieve his dream. In this physical, fast-paced, humorous play the message from the Sky God to Anansi applies to us all: when you share stories, you are richer for it.

### About the Auditions

No experience necessary. PARENTS/GUARDIANS must fill out all audition paperwork.

**Notification of conflicts with the rehearsal schedule will be required of all auditioners at the time of the audition.**
